## DTI Re-locating to new facility to prepare for Product Development stage.

**(Ranlo, North Carolina)** Today, Defense Technologies Inc. (DTI) announced they are re-locating to a facility on X-Ray Drive in Gastonia, North Carolina. This re-location coincides with their intent to cycle into the Product Development phase of existing and future defense efforts and contracts.

“This new location provides us the needed access to further our developmental process and begins our Product Development Phase of items emerging from our Research and Development (R&D) and associated Test and Evaluation (T&E) accomplishments.
